Dear Parents, Staff and Community Members:

The Intensive Education Academy was notified that a member of our school community has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19). The affected person has been instructed to remain home in self-isolation for 10 days and has been provided with additional instructions to follow prior to returning to school.

Contact tracing has been completed. Those who have been identified as close contacts have been notified and will be quarantining and/or monitored as necessary.

While this case was identified just days after our last case, it is important to note that these two cases are not connected in any way. All signs indicate that these individuals were infected outside of our school community. Cases within our local community remain low as compared to last year, and West Hartford is considered an area of low community level transmission.

Please remember that it is essential that members of our school community, students and staff, stay home if they are feeling unwell or may or if they have come in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. We remind you to review the health checklist daily.

This is the time of year when we typically see an increase in cold and allergy symptoms. Unfortunately, many cases of COVID-19 are now presenting with similar symptoms of runny nose, nasal congestion, cough, headache and/or sore throat, even in persons who are vaccinated. For this reason:

- Please call and keep your child home when they have these mild cold- or allergy-like symptoms, contact their provider and request a COVID test before they return to school. Call the school nurse if there is any question about the type of test required.
- If your child has asthma or allergies that flare up at this time of year, discuss with their provider the best way to manage their conditions, in order to prevent symptoms that might mimic those of COVID-19.
- Remember that the masking, handwashing and distancing precautions we are taking at school
 help prevent the spread of colds, flu and other diseases in addition to COVID-19. Practicing
 these measures in the community as well will help keep us all healthy.



Be especially minds	ful of monitoring yourself and family members for these COVID-19 symptoms:
□ F	Fever (100.4° Fahrenheit or higher)
	Chills or shaking chills
	Incontrolled new cough (not due to other known cause, such as chronic cough)
	Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
	New loss of taste or smell
	Other non-specific symptoms such as headache, fatigue, sore throat, runny nose, nasa congestion, body aches, nausea/vomiting/diarrhea
