Dear Parents, Staff and Community Members:

I am writing today to inform you that we have several community members currently in quarantine for COVID-19. Some of these community members were in contact with someone who has tested positive for the coronavirus (COVID-19), others need to quarantine due to travel regulations. None of these community members are infected individuals. The Health Department does not recommend IEA take any additional action at this time.

As the weather gets colder, we are seeing a rise in cases across the country and in our state. Unfortunately, predictions expect this trend to continue and as a result, we expect we will have additional quarantine cases. These cases require only the affected individual to quarantine and do not impact our larger school community. As such, we have created a [chart on our website](#) to update our school community on these cases and will no longer provide a letter for each quarantine case.

We will, however, send out written communication on any confirmed cases within our school community. These cases would require isolation of the affected individual and contact tracing throughout our school to see if it is necessary for anyone else to quarantine. These cases will be updated on the chart as well.
